History in Opotiki cemeteries

WHAKATANE Historical Society is indebted to Opotiki historian Sonia Edwards, who conducted members on a recent guided walk around Opotiki's three cemeteries.

Society members found Ms Edwards to be an extremely informative and knowledgeable guide as the group enjoyed a sunny afternoon visiting Opotiki's cemeteries.

First up was the old military cemetery in the vicinity of Hiona St Stephen's Church, where missionary Carl Volkner was murdered in 1865.

The next stop was the new cemetery and then it was down to the very old cemetery just out of town.

Society members found it sad reading the grave stones of the many children who were either stillborn or who died very young.

They also found that many were drowned because for a long time the only way out of Opotiki was by crossing rivers.

Members thanked Ms Edwards for her time and for the effort she put in planning the most interesting tour.
