Seufert races to fourth in Toi's

OPOTIKI runner Luke Seufert finished fourth at Toi's Challenge in Whakatane on Sunday.

He finished in one hour 30 minutes, just over three minutes behind race winner, Whakatane's Aidan Campbell.

For the third consecutive year Tauranga's Sabrina Grogan won the senior women's race, finishing in 1.32.

More participants than ever before took on the 18-kilometre run and walk around the Nga Tapuwai o Toi track and the 6km fun run and walk on the Birdwalk.

Participation numbers set a record, organiser William Doney said.

"There was 893 who took part this year. Last year there was 640."

Doney said numbers had been increasing every year, but this year saw an increase in all categories.

"As for the course, it was excellent.

"The Whakatane District Council,

Department of Conservation and Whakatane Athletic and Harrier Club members have done a good job with the course.

"It is a very good course and because it is a hard run, it is popular."

Doney said the event attracted people from all around New Zealand and accommodation was booked out.

A highlight for Doney this year was participants giving positive feedback.

"It was good to see people actually commenting about it after the race. People approached me and other committee members to thank us for the day.

"The committee is really happy about it."

The success of the event meant sponsors were lining up for next year too, he said.

"Another highlight for me was seeing Whakatane Intermediate School students perform a haka before the race.

"It was good to see more schools involved too."
