The voter return percentage was 32.54%, being 2,876 votes received from 8,839 eligible voters, of which 46.49% voted on the internet and 53.51% voted by post or at an information hui.

What Happens Next
 The Ministers for Treaty of Waitangi Negotiations and for Māori Development will consider the results before deciding whether or not the Crown will resume negotiations with the Pre-Settlement Trust or explore other options involving Whakatōhea. The claimants will be entitled to reconsider their existing applications to the Waitangi Tribunal to hear district inquiries. Whakatōhea may also reconsider their collective approach to a settlement depending on the results of the vote and the hapū preferences.
