HANCOCK FOREST MANAGEMENT WILL SOON BE UNDERTAKING HARVESTING OF THE PINE PLANTATION AT TUNAPAHORE B2A INCORPORATED FARM, 2558B STATE HIGHWAY 35, HAWAI

As many coast residents will be aware, there are important cultural sites within the block including large pa and mara kai sites that are visible from the highway. Hancock Forest Management and the owners of Tunapahore B2A are working with Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga to ensure that none of these special places are damaged or affected by the harvesting activity. Heritage New Zealand have granted an archaeological authority in order to permit the harvesting work to be done, and have imposed conditions on the work process.

During the week, commencing 19th November 2018 a team of archaeologists from InSitu Heritage Ltd and the University of Otago will be monitoring earthworks that Hancock Forest Management will be carrying out in preparation for harvesting. This will involve ground disturbance in the pasture areas adjacent to the pine plantation. As this work will be carried out close to the cultural and archaeological sites; there is a reasonable likelihood that buried evidence of gardening and living sites will be uncovered. The archaeological team will be on hand to record and investigate any features that are exposed during the earthworks. The result of the archaeological investigation will be fully reported to the landowners and Heritage New Zealand.

The consent granted by Heritage New Zealand also requires that Hancock Forest Management have appropriate tikanga and cultural monitoring in place. This is being arranged with the assistance of the Committee of Management of Tunapahore B2A.
