New coach for Future Leaders

OPOTIKI'S team of Future Leaders are once again looking to better the community, under the leadership of Keri Impey. Joining her will be catalysts Tayla August, Harmony Clay, Te Aho Jordan and James Sandbrook. Tayla and James are reprising their roles as catalysts from last year, while Ms Impey will be taking over from coach Toiroa Williams. Originally, she considered being a temporary coach for the group but Ms Impey was asked to stay on for the full year after her performance at a training seminar in Wellington.

"I was nervous going into the training, but I walked away feeling a lot more confident about what I can bring to the programme," she said. "I'm really excited, this is an awesome opportunity to grow and overcome challenges." Ms Impey said one of her goals for the year was to move forward with the team's project from last year, while also introducing another project. "Our book is definitely a huge goal, but we're going to try challenging ourselves with two projects this year," she said. "It's going to be awesome." With four catalysts, the programme is set to run differently this year with each catalyst leading a team of four to five

future leaders in coming up with ideas to improve the community. "We'll discuss all the ideas together, and then make one main goal for our team," Ms Impey said. The best idea across the eight communities involved with Future Leaders will receive \$500 to kickstart it, and Inspiring Stories will match future crowdfunding up to \$1000. Ms Impey said she was looking for high levels of community involvement in the programme and feedback on what residents felt the community needed. "I want our catalysts and public to have a big say," she said.

Mural restoration under way

IN an effort to restore Opotiki's many murals to their former glory, the Opotiki Children's Art House is working with the community to paint over the damage. Plans point to all murals being restored by 2020, accompanied by an all-new "mural tour".

According to Shona Hammond-Boys, this tour will run year-round through Opotiki, with a bus showing off all the murals around the town. "Young Opotiki people painted iconic murals over the past 10 years and have returned to restore these

murals to their best condition," she said. The restoration effort will happen during 2019, with support from the community through a Givealittle page and support from Resene. "By working together, the goal to have our mural tour ready for 2020 will make us all

proud," said Ms Hammond-Boys. "A great clean-up start has been made on the damaged wharf mural and it is wonderful to be back working with the artists who painted that mural in the beginning. Opotiki has very creative young people."

RAHUI DECLARED OVER TE AHIAUA (WAIOTAHE PIPI BED) AND WAIOTAHE RIVER

Te Upokorehe Iwi have declared a Rahui over the Waitoaha Estuary and Waitoaha River through to Te Kahikatea following the fatal crash near Toone and Ruatuna Road on Monday 18 February.

The Rahui will be in place for 21 days from Monday 18 February 2019, and will end on Monday 11 March 2019.

During this period there will be NO swimming or taking of Kaimoana and freshwater fish or plants from the Waitoaha Estuary or the Waitoaha River.
